

Local Author Collection Guidelines

We appreciate your interest in submitting your work to Henderson Libraries. Please take a moment and read our guidelines:

- The author or illustrator is a resident of Clark County, Nevada.
- Submitted material will be reviewed by Henderson Libraries staff and evaluated on the following criteria: writing quality and clarity, including proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation. A copy of each review can be requested from the Adult Services Staff. This review process can take several months.
- Due to budget constraints, the Henderson Libraries cannot purchase local works. However, if an author chooses to donate a single copy of his or her work, it will be accepted for review.
- Adult and juvenile books are accepted.
- Print, audio and/or electronic versions are accepted.
- Electronic versions must be submitted in one of the following formats: Adobe EPUB, Open EPUB, Adobe PDF, Open PDF. Cover art, if available, must be in PNG, GIF or JPG format. All electronic submissions must be accompanied by a signed E-Book release form.
- Materials may be excluded if the format is unsuitable for library circulation: poor binding, loose-leaf, broadside, spiral bound, etc.
- As our Donation Guidelines states, “We may decide to: add them to the library's collection; put them in the Friends of the Library Book Sale; discard them; or donate them to another library or organization”. All donated items become property of Henderson Libraries and will not be returned to authors.
- Henderson Libraries does not guarantee that the item will be kept permanently in the collection. Author titles added to the collection will be assessed on a routine basis by staff using the same guidelines that are applied to other materials in the Library's collection.
