Ghost & Pumpkin Halloween Garland


As ghost, goblins, and witches take flight, and all kinds of things go bump in the night, we hope you'll enjoy creating this fun and cute ghostly trio and their pumpkins!

Your craft kit includes:

- 1 Tassel Board
- 1 Pompom Board
- 2 Small Orange Yarn Balls
- 3 Pre-cut White Yarn Bundles
- 1 Small Black Paper Square
- 2 Pre-cut 13 inch Green Yarn Pieces
- 3 Pre-cut Small White Yarn Pieces (8-10 inch)
- 3 Pre-cut Medium White Yarn Pieces (20 inch)
- 1 Pre-cut Large White Yarn Piece (37 inch)

Additional supplies needed:

- Scissors
- Hole Punch
- Hot Glue Gun
- Glue Stick

Ghost Tassel

- Wrap 1 pre-cut white yarn bundle around the tassel board 40 times.
- Once the yarn is fully wrapped, carefully slide the yarn from the tassel board and slide a pencil into the top of the yarn loops — This will make it easier for you later to slide the single piece of yarn for the garland.



- Now, take one of the pre-cut 20 inch medium pieces of white yarn and tie it around the whole bunch of wrapped yarn, just below the pencil.
- Slide the pencil out of the top loop of the yarn bundle and pull one of the pre-cut 8-10 inch small white yarn pieces through the top loop.
- Knot the end of the yarn piece, creating another loop.
- Now, to create the tassel, cut through the loops at the opposite end of the yarn bundle.



- With your hole punch and the black square of paper, punch out 3 dots.
- Take your hot glue gun and apply glue to the black dots and press them to the top of your tassel, creating the ghost face.
- Repeat the steps for the remaining white yarn bundles.







<u>Pumpkin Pompom</u>

- Wrap an orange yarn ball around the small pompom board 100 times.
- On one side of the pompom board, slide the pre-cut 13 inch green yarn through the middle of orange yarn & tie the green yarn tightly around it.
- Now, slide the wrapped orange yarn bunch off of the pompom board & cut through the center of the untied side of the yarn bunch.
- Trim the yarn until it's the size and shape you want your pompom to be.

DO NOT TRIM THE GREEN YARN!

- Once your pompom is trimmed, then tie the ends of the green yarn together to make a loop to later add to the garland.
- Repeat all steps with the second orange yarn ball.













Making the Garland

- Take the pre-cut large 37 inch white yarn piece & tie a small loop at each end.
- String your first tassel ghost onto this large yarn piece.
- Next add a pumpkin pompom.
- Continue this way until all ghosts and pumpkins are strung on the yarn.

Hang Your Garland and enjoy!
